# IT IS YOUR DUTY AS AN APPLICANT TO PLACE THE PERMIT CARD IN A CONSPICUOUS PLACE ON THE PREMSISES. VISIBLE FROM THE STREET WHERE BUILDING IS TO BE ERECTED AND PROTECTED FROM WEATHER!!!

NOTE: Should you employ an out of state contractor, ensure the contractor follows WISCONSIN CODES

### Make Checks Payable to the Town of Beloit, Permits Are Required For:

The Following Information is Required for Most Permits:

Two sets of building plans showing:

- Elevations.
  - Footing and foundation plan.
  - Soil erosion plan.
  - > Heat Loss calculations for new dwelling.
  - > Truss engineering data if trusses are used.
  - Cross sectional view.

## THE INSPECTIONS NEEDED ARE AS FOLLOWS:

- Sanitary Sewer, Storm Sewer, and Water Lateral <u>BEFORE</u> backfilling of trench. System should be on test at time of inspection.
- Footing Forms, **<u>BEFORE</u>** any concrete is poured.
- Foundation Wall, Drain Tiles, after 12" of stone is in place on top of tiles and 12" beyond edge of footing.
- Building Sanitary Drain <u>BEFORE</u> basement floor is poured and after vapor barrier is in place. Clean out bleeder ends!!
- Electrical Service, **<u>BEFORE</u>** Electric Utility connection etc. underground pedestal or overhead service.
- All roughs must be called in at one time. (Carpentry, Electric, Plumbing, and HVAC).
- Insulation **<u>BEFORE</u>** applying any finished materials.
- Final Inspection, of all carpentry, Electrical, Plumbing, HVAC and other mechanical installations, all at one time, <u>BEFORE</u> any occupancy. If on municipal water, water meter must be installed.
- Occupancy Inspections address numbers to be posted on property.

Any person(s) who shall violate any of the provisions of the Inspection requirements, will be subject to fines which shall be levied against the owner(s) of said property or each violation above, and/or any other violations of Local and/or State Codes.

If no violations of the ordinance or any other law is found, the Building Inspector shall issue a Certificate of Occupancy stating the purpose for which the building is to be used. No building or part thereof shall be occupied until such certificate has been issued, nor shall any building be occupied in any manner, which conflicts with the conditions set forth in the certificate of occupancy.
